

ACPA – DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

Eligibility Criteria and Nomination Form

The Distinguished Service Award shall be given to an individual, member or non-member, who has demonstrated exceptional service and contribution to the ACPA.

After nomination by a member of the Association and review of his or her qualifications by the Honors and Awards Committee, a candidate may be granted the Distinguished Service Award by a two-thirds majority approval of the Executive Council.

Supporting Letter

This nomination form is to accompany the supporting letter from the individual nominating the candidate. The letter should provide details of the candidate's accomplishments and contributions that are deemed worthy of the ACPA Distinguished Service Award.
