

ACPA - HONORS OF THE ASSOCIATION

Eligibility Criteria and Nomination Form

The Honors of the Association shall represent the highest expression of respect and gratitude the Association can bestow and shall be granted to those individuals whose lifetime of research, health care delivery, or leadership has advanced, significantly and uniquely, the amelioration of physical, behavioral or social handicapping conditions of cleft lip and palate or other craniofacial anomalies.

After nomination by a member of the Association and review of his or her qualifications by the Honors and Awards Committee, a candidate may be granted the Honors of the Association by a two-thirds majority approval of the Executive Council.

Supporting Letter

This nomination form is to accompany the supporting letter from the individual nominating the candidate. The letter should provide details of the candidate's accomplishments and contributions that are deemed worthy of the ACPA Honors.
